



2011 Northwest & Pacific Region Medal of Honor Program

Purpose: to “select and recognize an individual member of the AIA Northwest and Pacific Region who has consistently demonstrated excellence in design, the practice of Architecture, Architectural education, or service to the profession, which has promoted public understanding of Architects and Architecture, and who has made notable contributions unique to this Region.”

Award: a certificate and medal, gold color and green cloisonné, to be presented at the 2011 NW&P Region Conference in Tokyo, Japan on November 13-16.

Eligibility Requirements: the nominee must be an AIA member in good standing who is assigned to a component in the AIA Northwest & Pacific Region.

Deadline: nominations must be received by 5:00 p.m., September 9, 2011 (Friday).



Submittals: All nominations shall be submitted electronically via email to Stephanie Davenport at stephanie@aiawa.org.

Who can Nominate: any Component/Chapter of the NW&P Region, the Board of the NW&P Region or any five AIA members in the NW&P Region.

Nomination Committee/Jury: Donald Stastny, FAIA, Chair; Norm Strong, FAIA; Chere LeClair, FAIA; Dr. Christine Bruckner, FAIA; Shawn Jenkins, Assoc. AIA.

Nomination Form: must be filled out completely and signed by the appropriate parties.

Other Materials: A Biographical Data Sheet and Statement of Contribution must also be completed and emailed by September 9, 2011.

Biographical Data Sheet: 500 type written words max./11 point font min.

Statement of Contribution: 500 type written words max./11 point font min. Please use carefully composed and thorough information as this may be the only information the jury will have.
